General Plan Amendment, Rezoning, Conditional Development Permit, and Environmental Review/ Stanford Management Company/ 2825 Sand Hill Road: Request for a General Plan Amendment, Rezoning, and Conditional Development Permit to construct an approximately 165,000-square-foot hotel facility comprised of 120 guest rooms, a restaurant, and spa and to construct approximately 100,000 square feet of office space in three buildings at a currently undeveloped property. The proposal would require the preparation of an Environmental Impact Report.
