NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the Planning Commission of the City of Menlo Park, California, is scheduled to review the following items:

**The following items require a Notice of Public Meeting or Public Hearing:**

**Use Permit/Michael D. Moyer/885 Harvard Avenue:** Request for a use permit to construct a second story addition to an existing single-story, single-family nonconforming residence that would exceed 50 percent of the replacement value of the existing structure in a 12-month period in the R-1-U (Single Family Urban) zoning district.

**Use Permit/Maryanne Pavaglio/72 Politzer Drive:** Request for a use permit for a first floor addition and remodeling of an existing single-story, nonconforming residence that would exceed 75 percent of the replacement value of the existing structure in a 12-month period in the R-1-S (Single-Family Suburban) zoning district.

**Use Permit/Michael and Annalisa King/842 Hermosa Way:** Request for a use permit to demolish an existing single-story, single-family residence and construct a new two-story, single-family residence on a substandard lot in regard to lot width in the R-E (Residential Estate) zoning district, and for excavation into a required side yard setback for a light well and egress associated with a basement.

**Use Permit/Jude C. Kirik/605 Hermosa Way:** Request for a use permit to demolish an existing single-story, single-family residence and construct a new two-story, single-family residence on a substandard lot in regard to lot width in the R-E (Residential Estate) zoning district.

NOTICE IS HEREBY FURTHER GIVEN that said Planning Commission will hold a public hearing on these items in the Council Chambers of the City of Menlo Park, located at 701 Laurel Street, Menlo Park, on Monday, April 17, 2006, 7:00 p.m. or as near as possible thereafter, at which time and place interested persons may appear and be heard thereon. If you challenge these items in court, you may be limited to raising only those issues you or someone else raised at the public hearing described in this notice, or in written correspondence delivered to the City of Menlo Park at, or prior to, the public hearing.
