Transportation Demand Management Program (TDM)

Facebook is invested in taking their employees off the road and providing alternative modes of transportation to help ease congestion. Over 47 percent of their employees commute to work using an alternative mode of transportation (shuttles, transit, bicycling, etc.)

Funding the Dumbarton Transportation Corridor Study

U.S. Highway 101 Managed Lanes Study
