NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that the City of Menlo Park, California has received an application for and has scheduled a public meeting on the following project:

Conditional Development Permit Revision, Development Agreement, Environmental Review/Facebook, Inc./1601 Willow Road (10-19 Network Circle): Request to revise the existing Conditional Development Permit, negotiate a new Development Agreement, and conduct environmental review. The environmental review will analyze replacing the existing 3,600 employee cap with a vehicle trip cap at the 1601 Willow Road site (East Campus), along with potential development of approximately 433,700 square feet at the property at 312-314 Constitution Drive (West Campus), which is bounded by the TE Connectivity campus (300-309 Constitution Drive), Bayfront Expressway, Willow Road, and the Dumbarton Rail tracks.

A Scoping Session is scheduled for the May 16, 2011 Planning Commission meeting at 7:00 p.m., in the City Council Chambers, 701 Laurel Street. The City has prepared a Notice of Preparation (NOP) for this project and will be conducting an Environmental Impact Report (EIR) Scoping Session as part of the process, during which the City solicits input from other agencies and the public on specific topics that they believe should be addressed in the environmental analysis.

Following the Scoping Session, there will be a Study Session at the May 16, 2011 meeting for the Planning Commission and public to become more familiar with aspects of the project. The City will also be preparing a Fiscal Impact Analysis (FIA) to analyze the fiscal impacts of the project on the City and other public agencies. The applications and associated environmental and fiscal documents will be reviewed by the Planning Commission and reviewed and acted on by the City Council at subsequent public hearings.


