- **Best Practices.** Learn about the "toolbox" of potential improvement measures that have been developed for the corridor. See how and where these have already been implemented elsewhere in the Bay Area.
- **Hands-On Street Design.** Put on your traffic engineer hat and have a hand at re-designing El Camino Real yourself! Add or remove travel lanes, parking, bike lanes, and sidewalks to create a new roadway configuration.
