Draft Specific Plan Release

The City of Menlo Park is pleased to introduce the El Camino Real/Downtown Draft Specific Plan to the community!

After several months of preparation, the Draft Specific Plan is now ready for public review. The draft plan builds on the extensive community outreach conducted in 2009. The plan will establish a comprehensive, action-oriented set of rules for the El Camino Real corridor and Downtown, and it is intended to represent an informed community judgment.

Community involvement is still an important part of this process!

In April, City staff will be holding two open house release events and one Planning Commission study session to present an overview of the draft plan, inform community members of how to obtain the plan, and highlight how comprehensive input can be contributed in May-June, when the associated environmental and fiscal analyses are available. Even if you haven't been involved in the process, you are encouraged to review the plan in detail and learn how to contribute going forward. 
