COMMUNITY WORKSHOP #1 -ISSUES AND OPPORTUNITIES

Community Workshop #1 will provide an opportunity for the public to learn about the Vision Plan process. Opportunities and constraints will be discussed, including the results of the public walking tour exercises and stakeholder interviews. Economic and traffic-related issues will also be discussed. Workshop participants will be given the opportunity to identify further opportunities and constraints in the Study Area.

COMMUNITY WORKSHOP #2-ALTERNATIVE FUTURE VISIONS

In Community Workshop #2 alternative approaches for the future of the Study Area will be presented. Participants will then break into small groups to analyze the alternatives. The groups will then be given the opportunity to present their comments and feedback on the alternatives to the workshop, including mixing and matching from among the alternatives, or introducing additional ideas.

COMMUNITY WORKSHOP #3-A DRAFT VISION

At Community Workshop #3 the principles that make up the Vision Statement for the Study Area will be presented. A conceptual plan will also be presented. Participants will have the opportunity to ask questions and provide further input on the vision for the Study Area.

PLANNING COMMISSION WORKSHOP-PLANNING COMMISSION REVIEW

The Planning Commission will review the Vision Plan and Conceptual Plan in detail. Recommendations provided in this workshop will be forwarded to the City Council for their final review of the Vision Plan.
