SCHOOL FEES ASSOCIATED WITH NEW DEVELOPMENTS

New development is required to pay one-time school facility impact fees for the school districts within which it is located. The Sequoia Union High School District collects school impact fees for itself and its feeder elementary school districts. Impact fees may vary depending on which of the following four elementary school districts serves the area:

- Menlo Park City Elementary School District www.mpcsd.org
- Las Lomas Elementary School District www.llesd.k12.ca.us
- Ravenswood City Elementary School District www.ravenswood.k12.ca.us
- Redwood City Elementary School District www.rcsd.k12.ca.us

Verification from the Sequoia Union High School District that the applicable fee has been paid is required prior to building permit issuance.
