The YAC consists of a maximum of 12 high school students for a minimum one-year term (September-May). Students enrolling in grades 9–12 are encouraged to apply for the 2020-2021 term.</p> <p>The YAC meets one to two times per month, usually from 6–7:30 p.m. on Thursdays, during the school year. The expectation is to maintain a 75% attendance record of all meetings and actively contribute in group projects and outings. All YAC members must live within Menlo Park City limits. Please verify address if uncertain.</p> <p>To apply for the YAC, send completed application packet and one Letter of Recommendation (i.e., teacher, coach, employer, etc. – exclude family members) to Recreation Coordinator Allan Bruce at awbruce@menlopark.org.</p> <p>Applications are due by 5 p.m., Wednesday, December 2. No applications will be accepted after the deadline. Interviews will take place December 7-11. Applicants selected for the interview process will be notified via email.</p>
