

Shadow studies were conducted on the Emerging Plan to understand the extent of shadows that might be cast with taller buildings in the Downtown and El Camino Real areas.

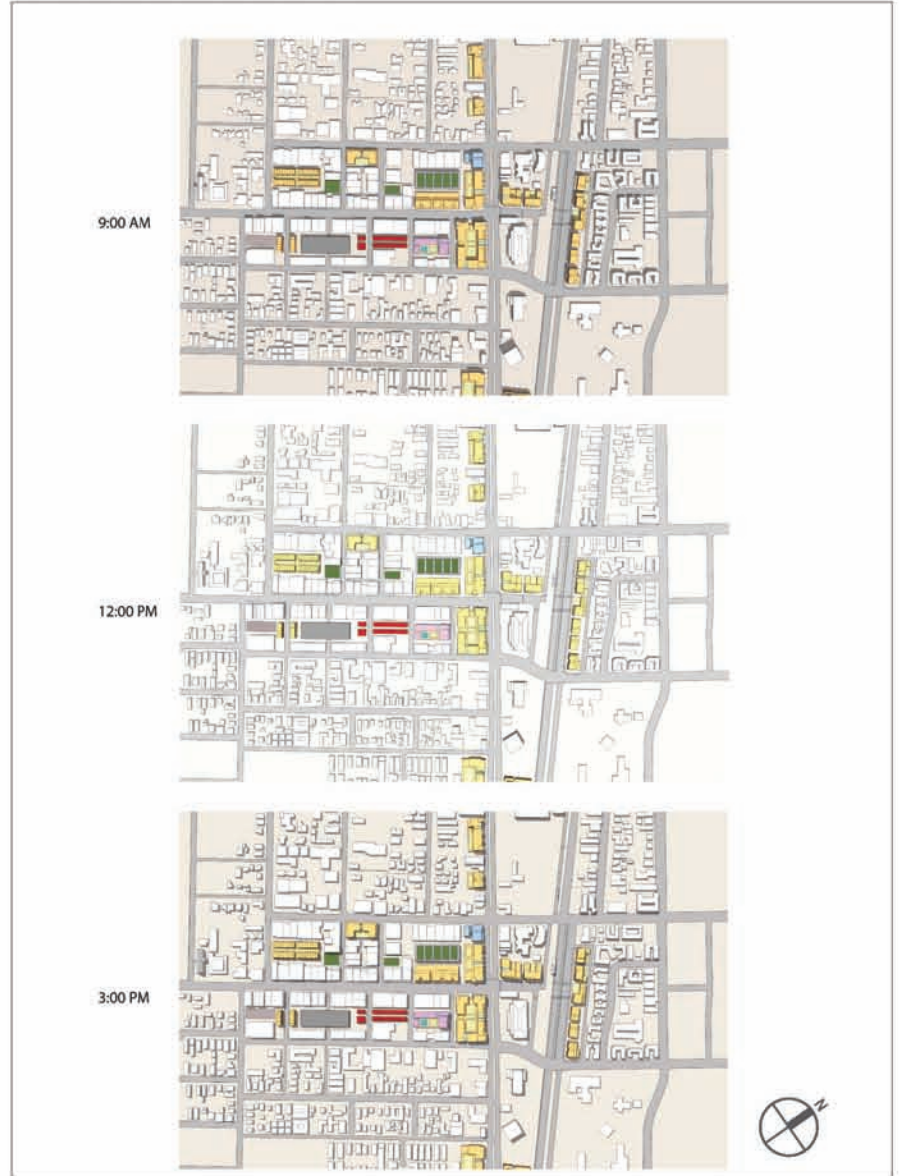
The shadow study was performed for several time frames, including the maximum impact conditions of the winter solstice (December 21). Please note that the study was conducted on an earlier draft of the plan, which included slightly different land uses, as well as taller buildings than those currently proposed in the Emerging Plan. Therefore, the diagrams reflect a greater amount of shadows than actually proposed.

Results from the study indicate that the shadows cast would not adversely impact adjacent single-family residential properties or sidewalks across the street.

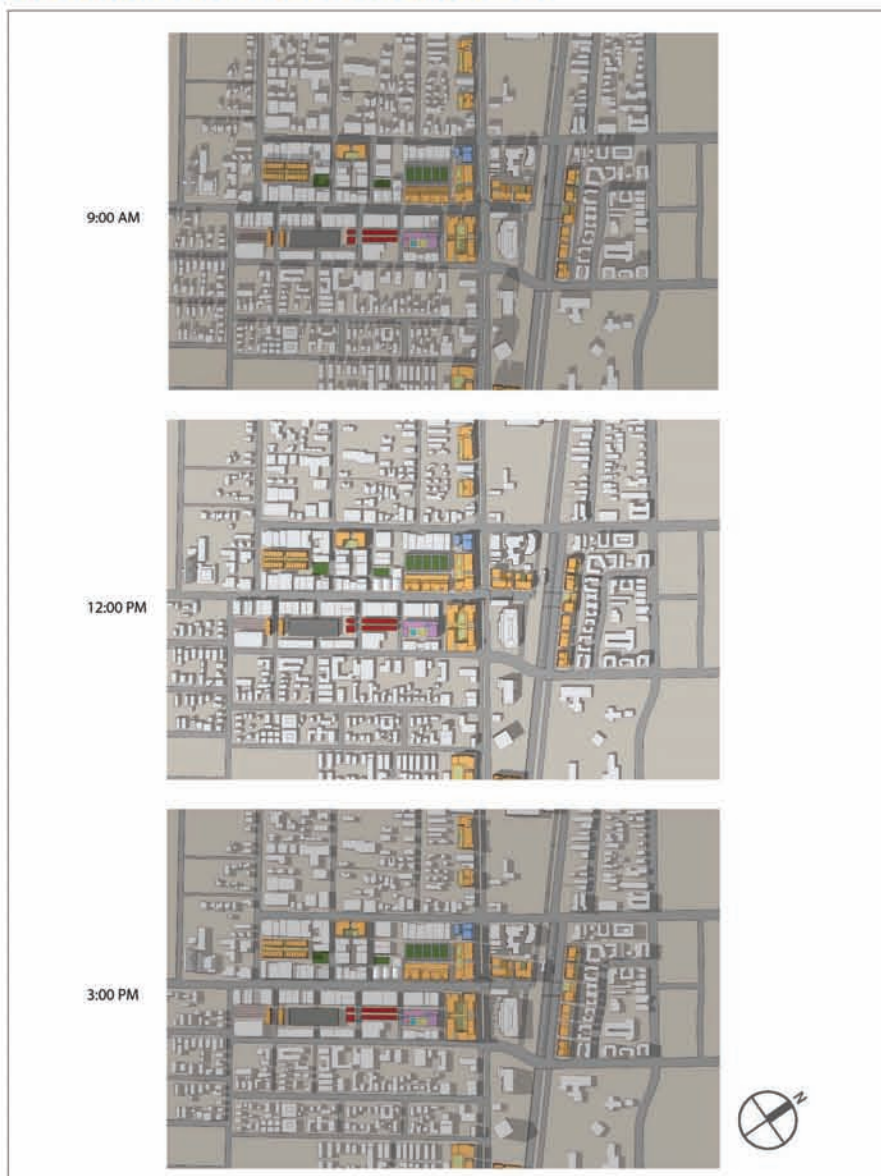
## Downtown Area: March 21
